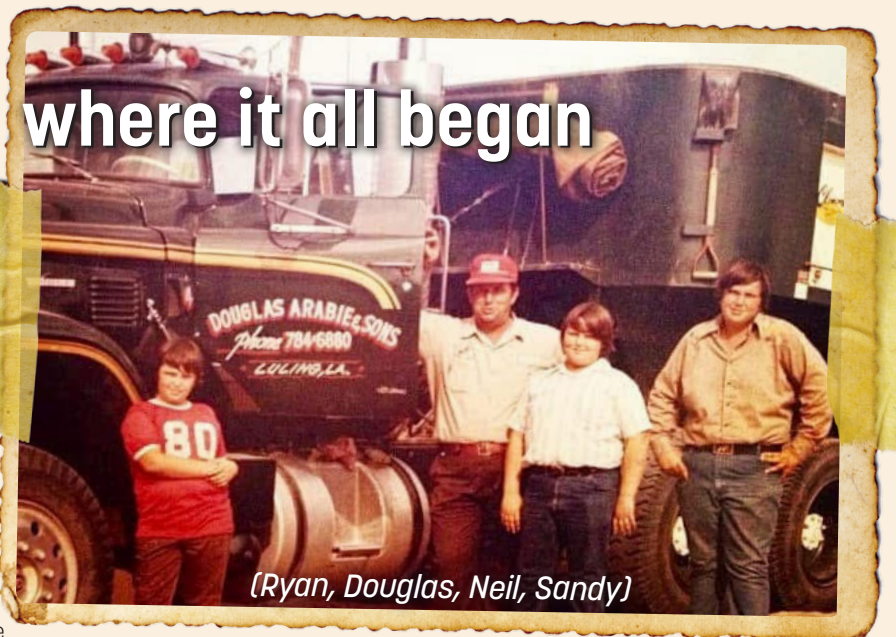

Project Updates:

SWE: Tolan Lake Terraces Project

The Ducks Unlimited Tolan Lake Terraces Project is located along Price Lake Road in Grand Chenier, Louisiana, within the Rockefeller Wildlife Refuge in Cameron Parish. The project includes the construction of approximately 44,575 linear feet of terraces designed to enhance the wetland habitat and provide significant benefits for migratory waterfowl and other wildlife resources.

In addition to its ecological value, the Price Lake Road area is a popular destination for outdoor recreation. Visitors frequently enjoy crabbing and fishing along the roadway, while the surrounding wetlands provide exceptional birdwatching opportunities. By improving habitat quality and ecosystem function, the Tolan Lake Terraces Project supports both wildlife conservation and public enjoyment of this unique coastal landscape.



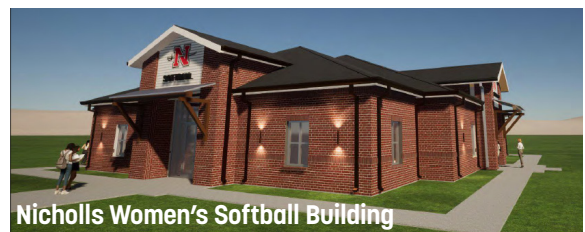

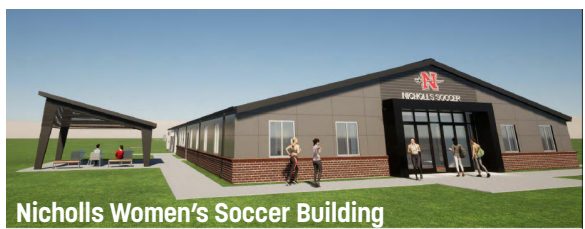

Project Updates: Hurricane Protection Morganza to the Gulf – Reach 3B Levee

The Onshore Materials team is making great strides in safeguarding Lafourche Parish! We are hard at work on the Morganza to the Gulf System, focusing on the Lockport to Larose Segment – Reach 3B Levee. This project spans 12,000 linear feet and aims to bring the levee's interim lift to a 7.5-foot elevation.

Partnering with the North Lafourche Levee District (NLLCD), our team is dedicated to providing much-needed flood protection to our neighbors and families. Thanks to the hard work on-site, we have successfully wrapped up several critical milestones, including Company Canal crossing, levee access roads, drainage channel excavation, and other site drainage improvements. The project is moving forward right on schedule, with its current lift standing at 5.5 feet!
